OFF-CAMPUS WORK STUDY AGENCY AGREEMENT

Adelphi University • Garden City, Long Island, New York 11530

CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH WORK STUDY STUDENTS ARE ASSIGNED TO OUTSIDE AGENCIES:

The agency is a non-profit organization and the work to which the student(s) will be assigned is in the public interest, which would not otherwise be provided, will not result in displacement of employed workers, and will not involve political activity for any political party.

The agency will supply Adelphi University with a brief description of the work to be performed by the student(s), bearing the signature of an authorized official of the agency. (See space provided below.)

The agency will not deny work to any student(s), or subject them to different treatment on the grounds of race, color, or national origin as provided in the Civil Rights Act.

The maximum hours under this program are 20 hours per week during the academic year, and no more than 40 hours per week during vacation periods. Any work beyond these hours is to be paid to the student(s) directly by the agency.

Payment to students will be made by the University at the prevailing rate of pay (\$. /hr.), of which the agency will contribute 20% for work, and will remit this to the University upon request.

The agency will be responsible for direct supervision of work performed, and will provide the University with a record of hours worked attested to by an authorized official of the agency.

The Agency shall be deemed the employer for purposes of this agreement. It has the right to control and direct the services of the student(s), not only as to the result to be accomplished, but also as to the means by which the result is to be accomplished. The Institution shall be responsible for determining that the students meet eligibility requirements for employment under the College Work Study (CWSP) Program, to assigning students to work for the agency, to determining that the students do perform their work in fact, and to disbursing the appropriate amounts to them.
