

Denise, daughter of the Rev. Denzil A. Carty and Sylvia O. Carty, spent her childhood growing up in St. Paul, Minnesota. She attended Barnard College and the School of Law at Columbia University.

She began her law career at Kaye, Scholer, Fierman, Hays & Handler of New York and held teaching positions at Northeastern University School of Law, Boston; City University of New York at Queens College; and Wayne State University Law School, Detroit. She also was a Research Fellow of the Institute for the Study of Educational Policy at Howard University and a Charles Revson Fellow for the Max E. and Filomen M. Greenberg Center for Legal Education and Urban Policy at City College of the City University of New York.

She was a member of the American Bar Association, the National Bar Association and the New York State Bar Association.

She was a human rights advocate whose activities included lecturing and membership on the Board of Directors of the National Employment Law Project, Co-Founder and Chair of the Board of Directors for the National Center for Fair and Open Testing, and Cooperating Attorney with the Center for Constitutional Rights.

Most of all, Denise will be remembered for the strength, support, encouragement and focus that she gave to all who touched her life.
