
# LIFT EV'RY VOICE AND SING

TRUE OUR NATIVE LAND.



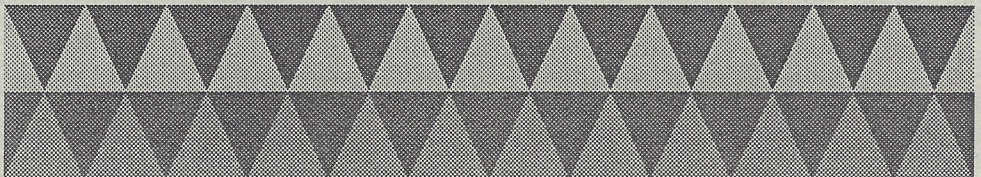

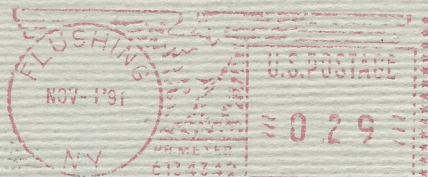
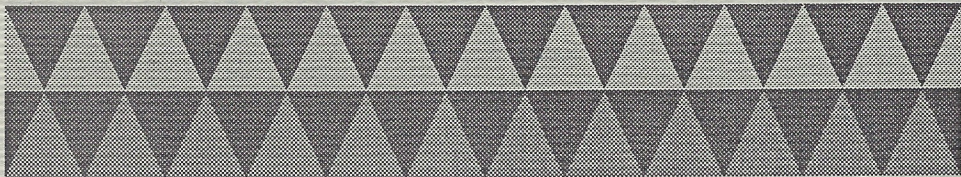
